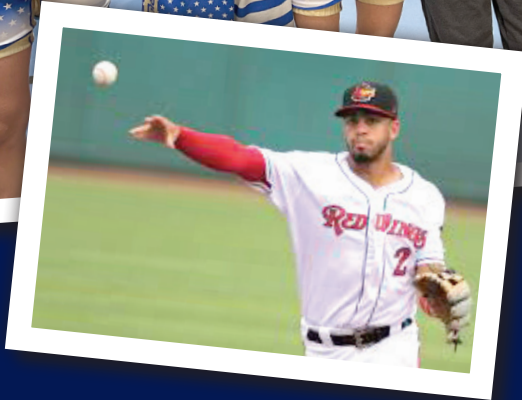

Registration is Ongoing – Register early so your class is not canceled. Please register at least 5 days prior to the start of each class.

Late Enrollment and Make Ups in Watercize – Registration stays open for the first half of the session. Rates are not prorated and students are encouraged to make up missed classes at other watercize classes. Make up classes must be completed within the same session.

Receipts – Receipts are provided electronically to all registrants who provide an email address. Please note that if you are a Roadrunner customer, you may not receive any emails from our registration system, Xenegrade.

Refunds – Full refunds are available up to one week prior to the first date of the class. After that, there are NO REFUNDS except for qualifying medical reasons and a note from a doctor.

Class Cancellations Due to Weather – Classes are held at school facilities. **When the school district closes due to inclement weather, all learn to swim, watercize, and community education classes are cancelled.** We attempt to make up all classes that have been cancelled due to weather closings.

- Registration Dates:** Registration for Watercize classes stays open for the first half of the session. Rates cannot be prorated for those who register for a partial session of Watercize. Students are encouraged to make up missed classes. Makeups must be completed within the same session.
- Attendance:** PATRONS are required to **sign the class log** at the front desk *before* entering the pool area.
- Make-ups:** There will be class number restrictions for each class. Therefore, drop in class make ups will not be allowed. Please call ahead to make a reservation for a specific class and day and we will do our best to accommodate your request.
- Cancellations:** All classes are held at school facilities. When the school district closes due to inclement weather, the pools are also closed, and classes are canceled. We will make every effort to make up canceled classes as schedules permit.
- Medical Absence:** Patrons with an unexpected medical leave of absence greater than one week may make up classes later in the session. Refunds for missed classes are issued only with a health care professionals note.

LIFEGUARD CERTIFICATION TRAINING - CERTIFICATIONS

This is a 31-hour American Red Cross training that prepares lifeguards with skills and knowledge necessary to keep patrons of aquatic facilities safe in and around the water. This class includes CPR/AED and First Aid for the Professional Rescuer.

Prerequisites: You must be at least 15 years old to take this course. To ensure that participants are able to complete the course, candidates are expected to pass the prerequisite swim test.

See below for swim test requirements. The pre test will be held June 12 at 4:00 pm at the WAC. All materials will be distributed to those students who pass the swim test.

A 300 yard swim using front crawl and breaststroke.

A 20 yard swim, feet first surface dive to retrieve a 10lb brick, swim another 20 yards back to wall, & climb out in a time of 1:40 or under.

Tread water for 2 minutes with no hands. Exit pool from the water to the deck without ladder or assistance.

Any Webster Central School District resident that passes the course and is hired by the WAC, will be reimbursed for the class fee.

Participants must attend all dates within the session to complete the training and be at least 15 years of age. No refunds are given once students begin. Please bring a suit, towel, and lunch to class each day.

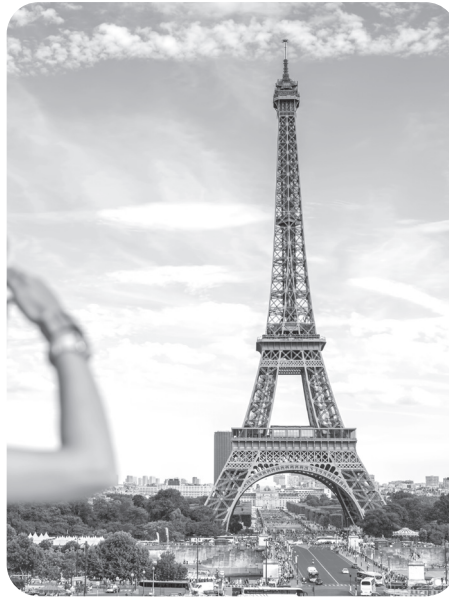
