

1. **Distribution** – The Webster Central School District will distribute a Chromebook to each student in grades 3-12 at the beginning of the school year.
2. **Ownership** – All Chromebooks provided by the district are the sole property of the Webster Central School District. Students in grades 3-12 who have purchased the Chromebook Protection Plan available through the district will be permitted to take their devices home with them daily.
3. **Term of Agreement** – Chromebooks will be distributed to students at the start of school at a time to be determined by the District before school begins in September. Chromebooks and any school accessories shall be returned to the District (a) upon the District’s request; (b) upon the student’s graduation from Webster; (c) if the student is suspended, transfers or withdraws from Webster; (d) or at the time of replacement (approximately 3 years), whichever date comes first. Students will be able to use the Chromebook throughout the entire school year and summer.
4. **Use of Chromebook** – Educational content and resources will be delivered through the Chromebook. Each day, students are expected to bring their Chromebook to school in working order and fully charged. Students, with support from parents/guardians, are expected to manage and handle their Chromebook in a way that minimizes the likelihood of damage, loss, and theft. All use of the Chromebook must be consistent with district policies. It is the responsibility of the student to backup any personal content from the Chromebook before the Chromebook is collected.
5. **Cost of Use** – The district will purchase the Chromebook and all required applications associated with it. Families must purchase the Chromebook Protection Plan prior to receiving the Chromebook to offset unanticipated costs due to damage or theft of the Chromebook.
6. **Protection of Chromebook** – Parents/Guardians must purchase the Chromebook Protection Plan from the District to cover repair and/or replacement costs in the event the Chromebook provided to the student is damaged, destroyed, or stolen. The Chromebook Protection Plan will insure the Chromebook until graduation, when the student transfers or withdraws from Webster, or at the time of replacement, whichever date comes first.

The cost of the Chromebook protection plan is a \$10 nonrefundable fee for students entering grades 3-12. The plan will cover the costs for repair and/or replacement of a Chromebook due to accidental damage or theft after payment of the appropriate deductible. If the Chromebook is accidentally damaged, the student or parent/guardian must pay a \$30 deductible, and the district will pay any further repair/replacement costs.

If the Chromebook is stolen, the student or parent/guardian must pay a \$50 deductible and the district will pay the remainder of the replacement cost. Before replacement of a stolen Chromebook occurs by the District, a police report must be filed by the student or parent/guardian for stolen Chromebooks.

The Chromebook Protection Plan does not cover, and the District will not be responsible for, damage or loss due to dishonest, fraudulent, intentional, negligent, or criminal acts. The parent will be responsible

for the cost to replace the device.

If students/parents/guardians do not enroll in the Chromebook Protection Plan, they are fully responsible for any repair and/or replacement costs in the same way they would be responsible for any other damaged or lost school property such as textbooks or music instruments and the District shall have no liability for repair or replacement.

The \$10 nonrefundable fee will cover for a maximum of 1 year for students entering grades three through twelve.

Students entering grades 3-12: At the time of replacement, a new \$10 nonrefundable fee will be necessary to insure protection of the replacement Chromebook going forward.

Chromebook Protection Plan Summary

Program Fees/Coverage

Non-refundable fee \$10.00
Damage Deductible \$30.00
Stolen Deductible \$50.00
Liability Limit (full replacement) \$350.00

Coverage: Repair or replacement of school issued Chromebook and or case. Will cover up to one charger and cable replacement per cycle, after which parent/guardian/student will have to either pay for a replacement or purchase their own. Does not cover lost chargers or cables; damaged chargers or cables will not be replaced unless district applied markings are still affixed.

No refunds after re-enrollment in the plan and delivery/pick up of device by student.

Coverage

Accidental Damage: Pay for accidental damage caused by liquid, spills, drops or other unintentional events (requires written explanation from parent/guardian).
Theft: Pays for loss due to theft (claim requires a police report to be filed with a copy provided to the district)
Fire: Pays for damage of the Chromebook due to fire (claim requires an official fire report from the investigating authority)
Electrical surge or Natural disasters: pays for damage to the Chromebook due to either (requires written explanation from parent/guardian).

Exclusions

Dishonest, fraudulent, intentional, negligent (not locked/stored in a secure manner or location) or criminal acts: Will not pay if damage or loss occurs in conjunction with a dishonest, fraudulent, intentional, negligent or criminal act, or if the Chromebook is removed from its protective case when damaged. The student / parents / guardians will be responsible for the full amount of repair/replacement.
Cosmetic damage that does not affect the functionality of the device. This includes but is not limited to scratches and dents. The Webster Central School District is not liable for any loss, damage (including incidental, consequential or punitive damages) for expenses caused directly or indirectly by the equipment.
