

# Webster Thomas High School Academic Recognition Program

The following is a system of recognition for students at Webster Thomas High School. The purpose of this program is to recognize the academic efforts and excellence of our students in a manner that is motivating, positive and attainable. Beginning in the fall of 2010, students will earn points based on their achievement within the current honor roll ranges. The points will be assigned as follows:

<u>Categories</u>	<u>Average Range</u>	<u>Points Assigned</u>
Honor Roll	85%-89.4%	25 points
High Honor Roll	89.5%- 94.4%	35 points
Honor Roll with Distinction	94.5%- 100%	50 points

As students earn points they will be recognized each time they accumulate 100 points. Recognition will consist of the following:

<u>Points Earned</u>	<u>Recognition</u>
100 points	Academic Letter
200 points	Bronze Pin
300 points	Silver Pin
400 points	Gold Pin
every 100 points beyond 400	Additional Gold Pin

Points will be cumulative over a student's high school career. For example, if a student earned honor roll status once each year, they would earn their academic letter in the spring of their senior year. Additionally, if a student earned Honor Roll with Distinction status each quarter of their high school career, they would graduate as a 5 Gold Star Senior.
